VODKA

Riesling is a white grape variety which originated in the Rhine region of Germany. This aromatic grape variety displays flowery, almost perfumed aromas, as well as high acidity. Riesling wines are usually varietally pure and are seldom oaked. A highly "terroir-expressive" varietal, Riesling from the Pacific Northwest ranges from dry to sweet, and has a crisp lightness that bodes well for easy drinking. Often there will be an easily detectable peach and mineral complex.

TASTING NOTES

Nose: Pleasant aromas of pineapple and candied ginger dominate the nose.

Palate: Soft, lingering flavors of apricot and dried fruit provide a gentle sweetness as they coat the mouth.

Finish: Fresh, slightly herbal finish with hints of citrus and peach.

OUR PROCESS

Vitis is an ultra-premium vodka made entirely from the "Vitis Vinifera" grapes grown on the Roza Hills Vineyards in Washington State. Unlike other grape vodkas, our vodkas are made to showcase the diversity of the Vitis vinifera grape by producing singular varietal spirits using the same care and techniques used to make fine wines. This particular vodka was made using Riesling grapes harvested in the fall of 2013 from our vineyard in Zillah, Washington, and processed into wine at our sister facility, Silver Lake Winery. After the wine was fermented cool to preserve its fresh fruit flavors it was brought to our Woodinville facility and distilled in our Kothe Vodka Still, then aged for three to four weeks in tank before being bottled.
